

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

CENTRAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE (HOMOEOPATHY), Lucknow

(Under Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India)

And

G.C. homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Bakshi ka Talab, Lucknow

1. Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 13th day of NOVEMBER 25 2025, between the **Central Research Institute (Homoeopathy), Lucknow** (hereinafter referred to as "CRI(H)"), functioning under the **Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH), Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India**, and [**G.C. Homoeopathic Medical College and Research centre**], a private institution affiliated to **Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University, Gorakhpur** (hereinafter referred to as "the College").

This MoU is established under the national initiative "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Abhiyan" (EBSB) to promote cultural integration, academic collaboration, and mutual learning among students and institutions across India.

2. Objectives

The primary objectives of this MoU are to:

1. Promote **academic collaboration** and **student exchange** between CRI(H) and the College.
2. Facilitate **exposure visits, short-term training, and internship programs** for students.
3. Encourage **joint activities** related to **research orientation, public health awareness, and community-based programs** in homoeopathy.
4. Foster **cultural exchange** and **national integration** among students as part of EBSB.
5. Promote **mutual sharing of academic and research resources** between the two institutions.

3. Areas of Collaboration

Under this MoU, both parties agree to cooperate in the following areas:

- **Student exchange programs** for observational visits and clinical exposure.
- **Joint organization of seminars, workshops, and awareness programs** on homoeopathy and traditional medicine.
- **Internship or project-based, problem-based learning, case-based learning opportunities** for undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- **Participation in cultural exchange events** under the EBSB framework.
- **Collaborative research** or documentation of case studies and clinical outcomes.
- **Outreach and public health camps** in urban and rural communities.

4. Roles and Responsibilities

A. Central Research Institute (Homoeopathy):

- Provide guidance, mentorship, and training facilities for visiting students.
- Facilitate participation of its researchers and clinicians in academic interactions.
- Share relevant research data, publications, and best practices (as permissible).
- Support organization of EBSB-themed events related to Homoeopathy and AYUSH systems.

B. [Name of the College]:

- Nominate students and faculty members for participation in collaborative programs.
- Facilitate student participation in exposure visits and field activities.
- Organize awareness programs, cultural activities, and academic interactions in collaboration with CRI(H).
- Maintain records and submit activity reports to CRI(H) and the EBSB coordinating authority.

5. Duration and Renewal

This MoU shall remain in force up to 31st March 2026 from the date of signing and may be renewed by mutual consent in writing.

6. Funding and Financial Arrangements

Each institution shall bear its own expenses unless otherwise agreed upon for specific programs or projects.

7. Monitoring and Reporting

A **Joint Coordination Committee** comprising representatives from CRI(H) and the College shall be formed to plan, monitor, and review the activities undertaken under this MoU.

8. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality of data, research findings, or any proprietary information exchanged under this MoU, except where disclosure is required by law or mutually agreed upon.

9. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising out of or relating to this MoU shall be resolved amicably through consultation between the authorized representatives of both parties.
